

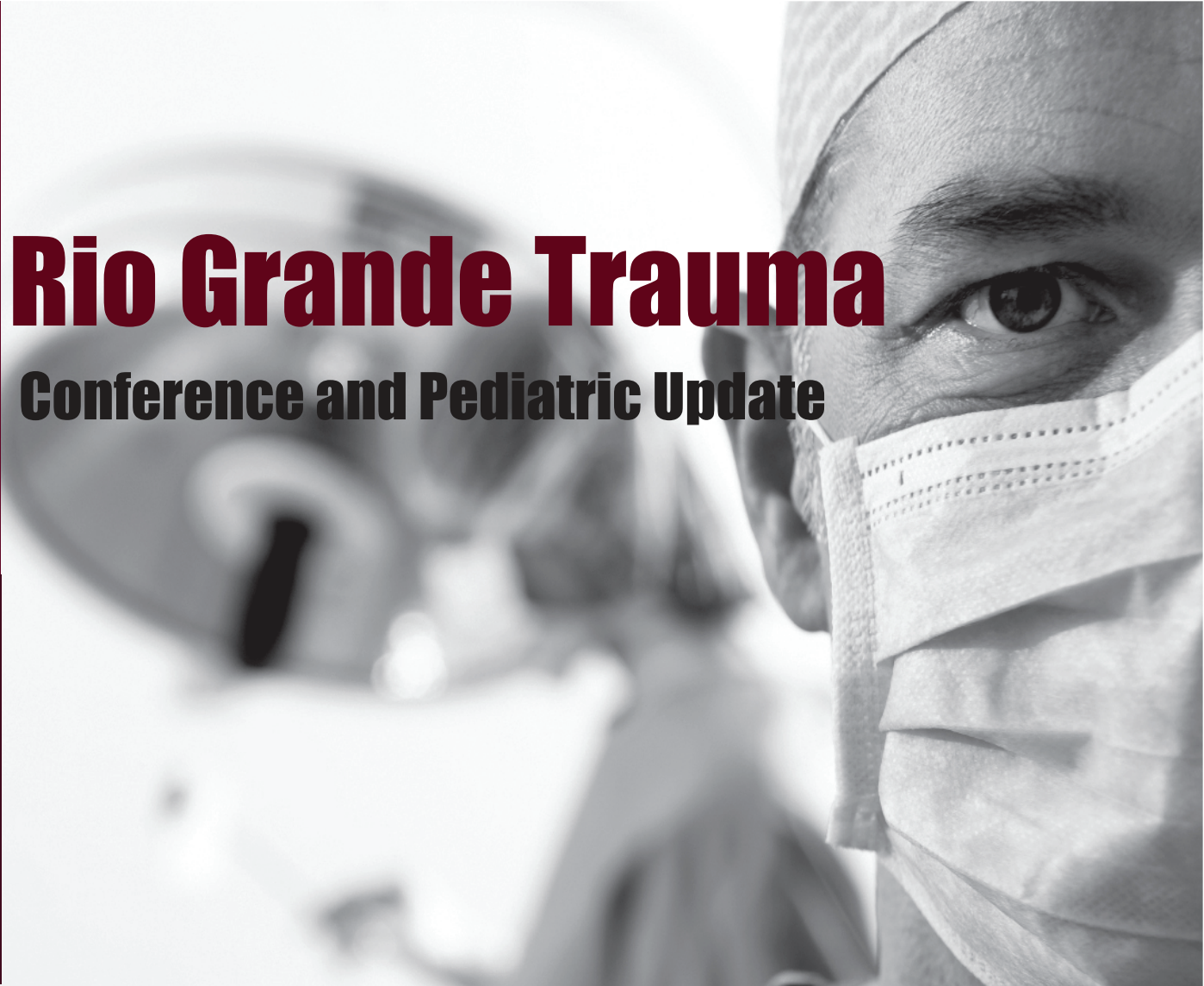

CONFERENCE OVERVIEW AND TARGET AUDIENCE:
